Curriculum Policy

TYPE OF FULL-TIME CLASSES AVAILABLE

1. English Study Camps aims to provide classes of English to speakers of other languages at CEFR levels A2 to C2.
2. The number of classes offered during the summer will depend on student requirements.
3. In addition to our regular English classes, ESC offers students and their parents the option of Future Business Leaders, Global Citizenship, and Football Academy* classes, depending on the centre. Details of these classes can be found in the current English Study Camps brochure and online.

THE CURRICULUM

The curriculum at ESC is designed with a wide range of materials to provide a balanced course and take into account the needs and requests of students.

The teachers are given a clear outline of the syllabus they will be following. There are guidelines in the Handbook for Teachers and teachers work with a “syllabus checklist” for all Explore English courses.

THE CURRICULUM WEEK BY WEEK

Each week, the teachers draw up a weekly plan (based on the syllabus) which is structured to offer a balanced programme covering grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, exam preparation (if applicable) and which includes the four skills and work to prepare for weekend excursions.

The weekly plans are produced as a result of discussion with students and close liaison between the teachers. They are designed to be flexible and can be modified at any time to meet the changing needs of students.

A copy of the weekly plan is displayed in the classroom each week and students are referred to it.

A course syllabus is also displayed in the classroom to show what has been/will be covered during the course. This is updated weekly by the teacher and students.

PLUS COURSES (PART TIME)

These are compulsory part-time classes to meet the needs and interests of students in English for specific areas. These focus on helping students to improve their English in one of the following areas:

- Global Journalist
- Film Making
- Presentations & Public Speaking
- University Preparation & Exam Techniques

Theatre & Drama
Drama & Movement
Coding**
Football Skills*

A syllabus has been developed for each of these classes, which includes all the elements outlined in our current publicity literature.

Teachers are free to tailor or supplement the specified materials to meet the specific needs/requests of each class.
